- How much preliminary data is expected in Investigator-Initiated Research Award (IIRA) applications?

- How do I determine which award mechanism or which funding level of IIRA I should apply to?
  - Please refer to section *II.B, Award Information*, of the program announcements for key features and requirements of each award mechanism, including features and requirements of the two levels of IIRA.
- What is the success rate of pre-proposals to be invited for full proposals?

- Does a first-time applicant have to start at a specific phase of the research pipeline?
  Applications can propose work on any phase from idea development to early clinical trial. It is the PI's responsibility to select the award mechanism appropriate for the proposed research.
