Supports platform development or infrastructure that can be applied to multiple rare cancers. Applications to the RCDA funding opportunity are required to include patient advocates who are involved with patient advocacy organization(s). The research team must include at least two rare cancer patient advocates as early and integral partners throughout the planning and implementation of the research project, including development of the research question, project design, oversight, and evaluation. Preliminary data are not required but may be included (translational research and clinical studies may be included). Submission must address the FY23 Platform Development Focus Areas.
