
FY16-FY22 TBDRP Portfolio by Pathogen/Disease/Condition (48 Awards)

'Lyme disease and associated co-infections' refers to studies of Lyme disease alone or with various co-infections commonly diagnosed with Lyme disease. 48% of these awards directly investigate or have implications in Post-Treatment Lyme Disease Syndrome (PTLDS), or persistent/chronic symptoms of Lyme disease.

'Other bacterial TBDs' currently includes Rickettsiosis and Ehrlichiosis.


'Viral TBDs' currently includes Powassan, Crimean-Congo Hemorrhagic Fever, and Tick-Borne Encephalitis viruses.

'Inclusive of all TBDs' is indicative of studies involving approaches applicable to any/all TBDs.

'Parasitic TBDs' currently refers to Babesiosis.

'Allergic conditions' currently refers to mammalian meat allergy (Alpha-gal Syndrome).
